Instructions

- 1. You will work in your row groups to write one group paper.
- 2. As a row group, agree on one scenario from the list to write about:
 - You are Lady Macbeth. Write a letter to Macbeth saying why you think he needs to kill King Duncan.
 - You are Macduff. Write an entry in your journal about why Macbeth is such a bad person and king.
 - You are Macbeth. Write a letter to Lady Macbeth saying why you think you shouldn't kill King Duncan.
 - You are the doctor. Write an entry in you medical journal about hearing Lady Macbeth's confession of King Duncan's murder.
- 3. Discuss the scenario as a row group and plan what you are going to write. Use the Character Summaries to read about the two characters for your scenario. Remember who you are writing as (your character's point of view), and who you are writing about.
- 4. Your group will work together to write ONE letter/entry for your row. Each person needs to give at least one sentence. Put your initials next to your sentence. Example: "We must kill King Duncan so we can take over Scotland and be rich. (KA)"

Make sure your paper has ALL of the following before you hand it in:

- · Your names, row number, and the date
- Your row's scenario
- At least 4 sentences answering your scenario (aim for 5-8)
- Initials next to each group member's sentence
- Correct formatting (letter/journal entry), spelling, and punctuation
